The Hospice Maui angels came in right away and their compassionate care gave my mother a chance to recharge her batteries. They treated our father like family; he loved them and eagerly anticipated their visits.

Our father had faced some difficulties in the hospital and was adamant he'd never go back. Wanting to honor his wishes and make things easier on our 81 year-old mother, we made the bathroom wheelchair accessible and installed a hospital bed.

One day during this time Dr. Nancy Long, a Hospice Maui physician, visited my art gallery and I asked her a question: would she be willing to meet with our parents to ensure that we were doing all that we could to support them both? She graciously agreed and soon informed me that our dad was "ready for Hospice now." I about fell over. How could he be ready for Hospice? We thought he would outlive us all.

I thought back to my father trying to use his walker, riding the stationary bike, lifting weights, keeping his spirits high and rarely complaining. So in love with our mother, he was in absolute heaven being home with her. Dr. Long helped us understand that this was our father's resilience; he was being strong because he needed to in order to stay home with our mother.

The Hospice Maui angels came in right away and treated our father like family; he loved them and eagerly anticipated their visits. And three months later my father, Robert M. Reeve, passed on peacefully at home, surrounded by love. And to this day, our family remains in gratitude to Dr. Long and the compassionate staff of Hospice Maui.
