Aloha everyone,

This fall is a monumental occasion for Hospice Maui. In November we are celebrating 40 years of serving our community with the highest level of professional and compassionate care, and in December it will be 5 years since we opened our Hospice Maui Hale!

I had envisioned our Hale as a place for dying hospital patients who no longer wish to receive hi-tech interventions. It is very heartening to see how that has come to fruition: In 2020, we had 155 admissions to our little 5-bed facility!

I have been at Hospice Maui for nearly 32 of its 40 years. When I started, I worked with a staff of six people. I now work with six department heads and a staff of 80 people. During our first full year of being Medicare Certified (1992), we admitted 39 patients to our program. In 2020, despite COVID, we admitted 450. That means we served half of the total deaths on Maui.

Our Board of Directors, consisting of highly qualified and deeply committed volunteer members of the Maui community, continues to set an example of excellent governance of a non-profit. I am so appreciative of their willingness to contribute their time and expertise to our organization.

I have been privileged to witness hospice care go from being completely unknown, to its current role as an essential part of the healthcare continuum. I am very grateful to be part of this shining example of hospice care.
